01 Be bold

A. We have complete confidence in being able to deliver for our clients. We do this by ensuring a massive stock range is available for dispatch at all times.



Whether looking for resourceful solutions for a guest bathroom or rich details to add to a decadent master bath, you are sure to find inspiration within the pages of Take a Bath.



Although the bathroom has historically been seen as a functional room, a growing number of architects and interior designers are seeing the space as an opportunity to flex their creative muscles. Take a Bath, published by Gestalten, looks at these creatives and how they shake up conventional thinking when it comes to bathroom design.

The book is the perfect showcase for how designers harness creativity and take a fresh look at the bathroom.

Taking in conceptual finishes from the contemporary to the classic as seen in the Terrazzo tiles designed by Max Lamb for Dzek (bottom right). The concept of tiles is pushed beyond the simple white square to encompass a range of textures, finishes and colours. Split into four sections focusing on different materials, the book looks at how they can be used in contemporary interiors. Natural materials are seen as more than just décor as the architectural merges with the interior. Framing, struts and beams become as much a part of the bathroom as the fixtures and fittings. Aged wood, copper and stone are used to bring heritage and patina to contrast with the crisp white finish of the baths.

There is also the world of the modern and conceptual interior to balance the more familiar finishes. Minimal approaches are seen from Piero Lissoni where resin, mirror and smooth rendered surfaces collide. And an intriguing and considerably more accessible look at the use of coloured pottery and baths along with new ways to use wood veneer and even wallpaper (main image). Take a Bath treads the line between the conceptual and the practical and introduces us to a community of designers seeing just how far they can push the bathroom concept. Whether you prefer to be traditional or modern, there is plenty of inspiration here for even the most modest bathrooms spaces.

Nowhere is this better summed up than by designer Roberto Palombo. "the bathroom of the future will increasingly evolve from a functional area into a living space.. a room full of colour, innovative materials and forms..."



Bathtubs in busy homes need to be a bit of a workhorse, from the bathing of small children to the multiple showers required daily by busy teens and adults. And don't forget the relaxing soak at the end of that day as you try to grab those few moments of peace and serenity. For all this, you need a thoughtful and flexible bath design.

The Delta/Sigma range started small, as do many of our ranges. But its flexibility and practicality soon brought demand for more and more bath types and sizes. The more compact Deltas have six size variations on the single end model alone. There are also two showerbath sizes options that help provide dual functionality so often needed in busy family homes.





One of the most common requests we receive from customers is the best way to take care of their new bath. *Cleaning a bath may seem straightforward but if you follow* our simple cleaning guide, you can guarantee your Carron bath will look as good as the day it was installed.





Cleaning should be done immediately after use, whilst the bath is still warm.

This way, the layer of insoluble soap, grease and dirt which would otherwise harden on the surface can be removed more easily.



We recommend simply using a small amount of mild detergent, or a bathroom cleaner such as CIF Cream Cleaner.





Avoid leaving lit cigarettes or any other heat source on or near the surface of the bath.

After cleaning, rinse thoroughly

Do not bring into contact with sharp edges. Pointed objects could scratch the bath surface.

Each time after use, clean the bath thoroughly with warm soapy water.



Here we speak to the company's Managing Director, Robert McAlpine, to find out more about the company history and get an insight into their plans for the future. Background Info: McAlpine is a Glasgow based plumbing manufacturer that employs nearly 800 people. Many of whom have generations of family working within our company.

Q. Are there any new/ interesting/innovative products coming out of McAlpine soon?

A. We are always looking to push our product range to the next level. This drive is why I enjoy working with innovative OEMs such as Carron Bathrooms, who think the same way.

This drive to innovate has led us to develop a new pipe fitting system called Suregrip, which will launch in 2022.

We are aiming to combine this products' unique function with existing products. And as a result, we have invested in new plant equipment to support the manufacturing and further expanded two of our factories in size.

Q. What areas of growth or change in the plumbing materials trade are you seeing now?

A. The pandemic has changed the way people interact with businesses, which is no different for the plumbing and bathroom trade. On the back of this, we have been making our product information more 'social' friendly with online videos to help explain our existing product range and to help launch new products.

McAlpine home orders have been a strong area of growth as well, helped by the fact that we are one of the few manufacturers who can continue production over the last two years. It hasn't been easy to achieve this under current circumstances, but we've

been able to make the most of these opportunities.

Q. How long have you worked with Carron Bathrooms?

A. The first time I worked directly with Carron Bathrooms was on the Celsius Range project back in 2008. Carron Bathrooms had developed a new bath design with the sharpest edges I had seen on an acrylic, moulded bath with a unique overflow design that sat flush with the tub. During our meetings with Carron Bathrooms, the idea was born to add a waterfall to the overflow plate. It was a really enjoyable and rewarding project co-developing this

great idea with Carron Bathrooms. And the fact the Celsius Freestanding model is still selling well and looks fresh to this day is testimony to the Carron design process.

Q. McAlpine is a family business. When and how was the company founded?

A. The company was initially founded in 1902, under the trading name of Egerton & Co., located in Govan, Glasgow. My Great Grand Father, J B McAlpine (founder), was the foreman in the factory before taking over the business. In 1906 he changed the company to the name McAlpine & Co Ltd.

Originally we manufactured lead pipes and traps. However, when my late father, J E McAlpine (who sadly passed away in 2021), joined the business in 1956/57, he insisted he would only join the company if we moved into the production of plastic.

My father was the third generation of McAlpine to work in the company. His insistence resulted in the company becoming the first producer of plastic plumbing products globally. Ironically the first trap produced is still on sale today and is still the market leader in the UK.

This event was vital in our history and began the story of pioneering at the core of McAlpine today.

Q. In what areas do you specialise?

A. At McAlpine, innovation is our key area of expertise. We are constantly investing in research and development, moving our product range and the world of plumbing forward.

Q. What do you think makes McAlpine unique?

A. Our trusted name. This trust has been built on over 100 years of
